How do I make an appointment? File insurance/pay for services???

Call St. Luke's at 706-2055. They will handle all the scheduling. St. Luke's will do all the billing and no payment is taken at the time of services. Depending on your insurance coverage, this service may be covered as a wellness benefit. Contact your provider if you have questions.

Are there any special requirements to receive this service?

- 1. Have no known breast problems (lumps, discharge, pain).
- 2. Be over 40 year old.
- 3. Be able to stand for the entire procedure.
- 4. Not to have had a mammogram within the last year.
- 5. Not be a nursing mother or less than 6 months post lactation.



On the day of your Mammogram, remember to . . .

- 1. Bring your insurance card with.
- 2. Wear a top that buttons down the front.
- 3. No perfumes.
- 4. No deodorants.
- 5. No powders.

How long will the Mammogram take?
